Citizens Seeks Water and Wastewater Rate Increases



Citizens Energy Group filed a petition with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) seeking increases in water and wastewater rates. If approved, residential customers would notice the following impacts on their bills starting January 1, 2014.

- Water bills will rise approximately \$3 per month.
- Wastewater bills will rise approximately \$10 per month and another \$4 per month starting October 1, 2014.

The rate increases are necessary to fund nearly \$560 million in system improvements between 2014 and 2015. Many of these improvements are mandated by the federal government.

- Water System: Nearly \$114 million is required to improve the water system by making updates that will prevent water main breaks, improve system flow and enhance the water treatment plants.
- Wastewater System: Nearly \$444 million is required to improve the wastewater system by constructing an underground tunnel system that will capture raw sewage, expanding wastewater treatment plants and by continuing the Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP) to reduce dangerous E-coli bacteria in neighborhood ditches and groundwater.

March 15th Marks End of State Moratorium on Utility Disconnections

The state moratorium on utility disconnection ends Friday, March 15th. The moratorium is in effect between December 1st and March 15th each year. It protects customers who qualify for the Energy Assistance Program (EAP) from their gas service being disconnected for non-payment. Since this is a heating assistance program, EAP customers are still subject to disconnection for water/wastewater services during the moratorium. Customers not receiving EAP funds are subject to disconnection for non-payment throughout the year.

For those customers who are behind on bills, Citizens is offering flexible payment arrangements, including weekly and bi-weekly payment plans. Please contact Citizens at 924-3311 to make arrangements before your service is disconnected.


