
How Does This Interact with Citizens' Water Supply?



- The Indianapolis area receives approximately 42 inches of rain annually; however, the water supply has not always been available when needed
- Citizens Reservoir, located on Olio Road next to Geist Reservoir, provides more than 3 billion gallons of additional water storage capacity to the Central Indiana water supply
- Excess flow from Geist Reservoir is diverted through an intake structure located between Geist Reservoir and Citizens Reservoir and can allow approximately **100** million gallons per day of otherwise underutilized water into Citizens Reservoir
- The stored water can be pumped back into Geist Reservoir during dry periods to flow downstream to the Fall Creek and White River Treatment Plants for distribution around Central Indiana
- The new Citizens Reservoir creates a more resilient water supply for Central Indiana and all Citizens customers by helping to ensure sufficient water supplies are available during periods of drought and to support continued economic development and growth for future generations
