SETTING THE STAGE







LIVABILITY

- Focuses on natural and cultural amenities that will improve the health and wellbeing of residents
- Includes pedestrian/bike connectivity, recreational programs and spaces, access to health care, food access, cultural attractions, and natural spaces









LIVABILITY GOALS

- Increase connectivity throughout the area by expanding trails, improving pedestrian infrastructure, and creating opportunities to access a variety of transportation options
- Expand access to art, nature, and recreation opportunities for all residents
- Become a model "Aging-in-Place" Community
- Improve public health and safety







OPPORTUNITY

- Focused on building human capital, supporting existing businesses, attracting new businesses, and creating jobs
- Includes expanding and enhancing neighborhood-level commercial development









OPPORTUNITY GOALS

- Establish a dense, mixed-use center of activity that attracts local businesses and enhances economic development initiatives
- Increase local employment opportunities and improve access to other job centers
- Create resources and spaces for entrepreneurship and minimize barriers to entry for small businesses
- Develop a strategy to increase the marketability of the neighborhood workforce







VITALITY

- Focuses on retaining and attracting residents to enhance the prosperity of the neighborhood
- Includes renovation, new construction, energy efficiency improvements, code enforcement, land banking, etc.









VITALITY GOALS

- Ensure that the area will remain affordable for residents of all income levels by developing programs to ensure current residents can remain in their neighborhoods
- Improve the quality of the existing housing stock and create a diverse range of new housing options
- Create a welcoming, equitable community for all residents







EDUCATION

- Focuses on creating educational opportunities for residents of all ages
- Includes access quality schools, child care, educational opportunities for adults, job training and employment skills, workforce development, etc.









EDUCATION GOALS

 Increase access to high-quality early childhood education and youth programming

 Expand opportunities for post-secondary education and workforce development
